

## 2014 MINI CAR CLASS RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR WASHINGTON JAYCEES DEMOLITION DERBY

The following rules and regulations set forth herein are designed to provide for the orderly conduct of Washington Jaycees Demolition Derby to establish minimum acceptable requirements for such events. These rules shall govern the condition of all events, and by participating in these events, all participants are deemed to have complied with these rules. No expressed or implied warranty of safety shall result from publication of or compliance with these rules and regulations. They are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to participant, spectator, or official.

The Washington Jaycees Demolition Derby official shall be empowered to permit minor deviation from any of the specifications herein or impose any restrictions that in their opinion do not negatively alter the safety factor. Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the Washington Jaycees Demolition Derby officials and their decision is final. **The Washington Jaycees Demolition Derby (Jaycees Derby) reserves the right to approve or reject all entries.**

### A. PARTICIPANT ENTRIES

1. An entry fee will be charged for each car. \$40 for car and driver, \$25 for rider, and \$20 for pit pass. To insure that we start race on time, any late entries (late is considered after 4:30 p.m. – weather may change this time) will be charged as follows: \$50 for car and driver, \$40 for rider and \$20 for pit pass..
2. All persons MUST sign entry form, insurance waiver and release form and purchase pit pass before entering pit area. PLEASE TAKE TIME TO READ!
3. No one is allowed in race area under the influence of alcohol. POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL IN THE PIT AREA WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF PIT PASS & EXPULSION FROM THE PITS.
4. First three heat races will be filled with early arrivals, then 4th and 5th heats filled as needed.
5. **All drivers/riders MUST be 16 years or older. Participants 16 & 17 years old MUST have a PARENT present in person, with identification to sign a minor release form. Pit admittance will NOT be authorized for individuals under 16 years of age. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
6. **SANDBAGGING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. THIS IS A DERBY, NOT A CAR SHOW... YOU MUST HIT OTHER VEHICLES OR THE CLOCK WILL BEGIN COUNTING.**

### B. AUTOMOBILE BODY REGULATIONS FOR MINI CAR CLASSES

1. Cars competing in Mini Car class MUST be 1980 or newer, engine MUST be 6 cylinder or smaller. Cars previously run in a demolition derby may install new front clip. Any clip in specified years may be used on any car, MUST be installed in stock manner. Length of angle iron MUST be no larger than 2 inches to secure fender to hood. Installation MUST be approved by a Jaycees Derby official. No trucks, jeeps, pintos, full frame or G body or pacers allowed. FORD, CHRYSLER, and any FRONT WHEEL DRIVE cars MUST be 1980 or newer. If dashboard is removed VIN # plate MUST REMAIN.
2. Car number will be exhibited on both front doors and on an upright number plate on the roof of car; minimum of 18" x 18". Car numbers are registered on a first come first serve basis. NO pre-registered numbers are allowed. NO LEGIBLE OR INSINUATED PROFANITY will be allowed within the car number or on the cars anywhere. The following numbers will not be accepted 69, 069, 169, 269, 369, OU812, etc. This is a family event and should remain clean to respect young spectators.
3. Must be powered by four or six cylinder engine.
4. Wheelbase must be **FACTORY 108 inches or less. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
5. No four-wheel drive vehicles.
6. **MANDATORY!** All four/six cylinder cars must have a cage. Four point minimum.
7. Stock gas tank MUST be removed from stock location and installed, securely in backseat of car.
8. All lines under car must be steel lines or if running rubber lines they must be inside of the car.

**Same rules as full size MODIFIED CLASS derby except as stated above**

### C. RACING REGULATIONS

1. All drivers MUST wear approved helmets, long pants, closed toed shoes and shirt.
2. Entries limited to one driver and one rider per class of car per show.
3. Qualified drivers may change cars for the Feature Event providing the car changed to has run in a prior heat at this derby.
4. A drivers meeting will be held by the Director of Jaycees Derby preceding each derby.
5. Inspection will close one half hour before posted show time.
6. All cars MUST be removed from derby site by 12:00 noon the following day unless otherwise stated at the drivers' meeting. Failure to do so will result in cars being removed by and becoming property of local salvage operator.

### D. PROTEST RULE

1. Only a DRIVER competing in feature can protest a car.
2. Protest must be made within 5 minutes of the checkered flag.
3. Driver must present \$100 in cash and state a specific protest on protested car to the Director of Jaycees Derby. Upon inspection by Jaycees Derby Director and Co-Chair should protest be found to be true, protestor receives \$100 back and violating driver will be disqualified. If protest is found to be false \$100 goes to driver being protested.
4. Protest is allowed in all classes.

### RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or participate in any way in the EVENT/S or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (defined as any area requiring special authorization, credentials, or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin.:

1. Acknowledges, agrees, and represents that he has or will immediately upon entering any of such RESTRICTED AREAS, and will continuously thereafter, inspect the RESTRICTED AREAS which he enters and he further agrees and warrants that, if at any time, he is in or about RESTRICTED AREAS and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the RESTRICTED AREAS and/or refuse to participate further in the EVENT/S.
2. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any RESTRICTED AREA, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the EVENT/S., premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or EVENT/S and each of them, their directors, officers, agents and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releases", FROM ALL LIABILITY, TO THE UNDERSIGNED, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFORE ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE EVENT/S, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
3. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releases and each of them FROM ANY LOSS, LIABILITY, DAMAGE, OR COST they may incur arising out of or related to the EVENT/S WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
4. HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE arising out of or related to the EVENT/S whether caused by the NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASES or otherwise.
5. HEREBY acknowledges that THE ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT/S ARE VERY DANGEROUS and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. Each of THE UNDERSIGNED also expressly acknowledges that INJURIES RECEIVED MAY BE COMPOUNDED OR INCREASED BY NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS OR PROCEDURES OF THE RELEASEES.
6. HEREBY agrees that this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the Releases, INCLUDING NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of Province or State in which the Event/s is/are conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid it is agreed that the balance shall, not withstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO ME AND INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW. AFTER READING THE ABOVE RULES & REGULATIONS INCLUDING RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT YOU MUST FILL OUT AND SIGN THE FORM ON THE BOTTOM OF THIS SHEET.
